#### NOTES

- Fees are due in advance on the first day of term. Fees not paid by the first day of a term are liable to an additional late payment charge equivalent to 5% per annum.
- The Acceptance Fee is paid on acceptance of the offer of a place and is refundable as laid out in the Terms and Conditions.
- School fees cover tuition, use of text books, school stationery and equipment, and school lunches. In the case of boarders, the fees cover board and lodging. Examination fees are charged as an extra. For full details please refer the Terms and Conditions.
- One term's notice in writing must be given before or on the first day of the term at the end of which a pupil is to leave Rookwood School, otherwise a term's fee will be charged in lieu of notice. A term's notice in writing is also required to discontinue optional subjects or individual learning support lessons.
- All fees are reviewed annually and normally take effect from the Autumn Term.
